

WELL DRILLING FEE

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WALPOLE NO. 92

BYLAW NO 1/2015

A BYLAW TO LICENSE MINING CONTRACTORS AND WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 9 (2) (C) OF THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw:
 - (a) "Contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation;
 - (b) "Drilling" shall mean drilling of any kind for the purposes of oil or gas; and
 - (c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92.
2. Every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a business tax in the municipality, shall before undertaking well-drilling in the municipality, pay to the municipality the following license fee:
 - (a) For the drilling of a horizontal well, vertical well or each subsequent leg – Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00)
 - (b) For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information- Two Hundred and Twenty-Five dollars (\$225.00).
3. Any contractor holding a license under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his license when required to do so by the license inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.
4. Bylaw 2/91, is hereby repealed.
