

# RECOVERY OF COST OF FIRE SERVICES

## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WALPOLE NO. 92

### BYLAW NO. 2/2017

#### BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR FIRE PROTECTIVE SERVICES COST RECOVERY


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows

1. In this Bylaw:
  - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
  - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92; and
  - d) "Fire Response" shall mean any response by:
    - i) The Wawota Walpole Wawken Fire Protection District (WWW Fire Dept) and
    - ii) The Moosomin & District Fire Protection District (M&D Fire Dept)
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with:
  - a) The current rates as charged from the responding fire service as determined by the Board of the WWW Fire Dept which is subject to change; and/or
  - b) The current rates as charged from the responding fire service as determined by the Board of the M&D Fire Dept which is subject to change.
3. The Council hereby authorizes the Administrator to invoice the ratepayer(s) for the cost of the fire protection services promptly following the date the service was received by the Fire Response and the invoiced fees shall be payable directly to the Municipality.
4. The Council hereby authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property (land, improvement or business) owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this Bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year. At calendar year end, the fire protection services will become part of their taxes and be subject to interest at the rate of 1% per month.
5. All funds relating to fire protective services, collected by the Administrator, shall be forwarded on to the applicable Fire Response.
6. No person shall refuse fire service.
