RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WALPOLE NO. 92

BYLAW NO. 11/2017

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92
2. The administrator, together with another person designated by council to sign cheques on its behalf, is hereby authorized to pay certain accounts
 - a) Wages and salaries payable to municipal employees;
 - b) Employee payroll deductions, including municipal contributions;
 - c) Telephone, heat, power services;
 - d) Collections on behalf of other taxing authorities; and
 - e) Other types of payments as may be authorized by council.
3. The administrator shall advise council at its next regular meeting of transactions undertaken in accordance with section 2 of this bylaw, including but not limited to:
 - a) The transaction date,
 - b) The number of the cheque;
 - c) The amount paid;
 - d) The payee; and
 - e) Any other information that may be requested by council.
4. Members of council are hereby authorized to expend for repairs in the case of an emergency to a public works by first seeking agreement from at least one other member prior to authorizing an expenditure.
5. When a member of council authorizes an expenditure in accordance with Section 4 of this bylaw, the member shall advise council at its next meeting the amount and nature of the expenditure.
6. Bylaw No. 7/89 is hereby Repealed.
7. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
