RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WALPOLE NO. 92

BYLAW NO. 01/2018

A BYLAW TO AMEND BASIC PLANNING STATEMENT BYLAW #05/2004

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - b) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Walpole No. 92.

2. Section 5.3.3 be amended to read:
 Subdivision for non-farm residential development at a density greater than five (5) subdivisions (including cut-off parcels as described in Section 5.3.2) per quarter section, will be considered on its merits by Council through a rezoning to a Medium Density Residential District. Council shall use the procedure outlined in Section 8.2 in making a decision on an application for rezoning.

3. This Bylaw will come into force upon receiving approval from the Minister of Government Relations.

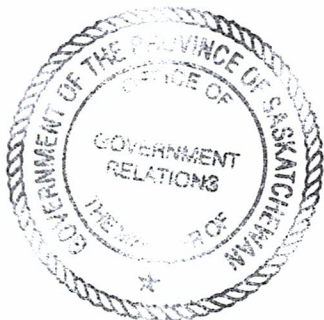
